Entry Requirements

Students applying for this qualification will need to show academic suitability. This can be done by providing a copy of a Senior Secondary Certificate of Education (year 12 certificate), or evidence of successful completion of an Australian Qualification Framework (AQF) Certificate IV or higher qualification (where the language of instruction is English). You will be required to undertake a Language, Literacy and Numeracy indicator prior to commencement of the course. This allows our trainers to identify any strengths and where additional support may be required. Students will also be required to have access to a computer and an internet connection to undertake their study and assessment.

Course Delivery

Our CHC53315 - Diploma of Mental Health is delivered online over 12 months with the requirement of completion of written assessments and 160 hours of supervised work placement.
